GENERAL POLICIES

- Families must be *Registered Parishioners* at Seton Parish *before* you can register your child for Faith Formation classes or Sacrament Preparation
- No child will be denied religious education for financial reasons. If you need assistance, please contact the Faith Formation office. Contact information is in the letterhead.
- *At St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, we care about the safety of your children! All volunteers working with children must comply with the Policy for the Protection of Children and Youth. Teens aged 14-17 must contact the Faith Formation office for training; adults (over 18) follow the steps as outlined on our website:*

FAMILY LIFE CURRICULUM

As an integral part of our Thursday Night Faith Formation curriculum, we use the Archdiocesan recommended Family Life curriculum. This age-appropriate program about Christian living, chastity, character formation, and safe environment training promotes communication between you and your child.

Family Catechesis parents will receive books for your children on Catechesis for Family Life to do at home. Questions on this curriculum may be brought up during parent meetings for discussion. This is not a part of your family scrapbook, but review pages may be brought to meetings for perusal.

SACRAMENT PREPARATION

- Sacraments are received in the parish where you are registered. A letter of permission from the pastor is required for your child to prepare and/or receive a sacrament outside of your registered parish.
- The Archdiocese requires a young person's participation in a Faith Formation Program ***the year prior to and the year of preparation***. Preparation for Reconciliation is required before preparation for Eucharist. Immediate preparation of the sacrament is required ***in addition to*** the regularly scheduled Faith Formation classes.
- Preparation for the sacraments of Reconciliation and First Eucharist is a separate program from Faith Formation. Please mark the box on the registration form under the word "Student;" you will be sent the appropriate form before immediate preparation begins.
- Confirmation at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton is celebrated in 10th grade, after participating in 9th and 10th grade High School Youth Ministry, a separate program from Faith Formation under the leadership of John Russell, ext. 229.

EMERGENCY CLOSINGS

Please do not park and wait in the fire lane, especially in the crosswalk. If you are transporting older children, drop off and pick up from the Parking Lot.

- Children K-3 should be picked up at the classroom door; and are not allowed to leave the building unaccompanied by an adult. Older children may pick up younger siblings and meet parents in the lobby. Please be prompt in picking up your child(ren).
- Middle School meets in Marian Hall (multi-purpose room).
- We follow Anne Arundel County Schools for emergency closings for weather. If after school activities are cancelled due to inclement weather, there will be NO Faith Formation that night.

COMMITMENT TO FAITH FORMATION AT HOME

- There will be seven (7) monthly meetings at the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish Center. The meetings follow 9:30 am Family Mass; 10:30 am – 12 pm.
- It is expected that all families attend all seven meetings.
- We suggest you do the activities *before* the monthly meetings.
- Each child enrolled in the program should choose two (2) of the suggested activities for the month to add to the "Family Scrapbook." One of these activities may be done at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton during the monthly meeting.
- There will be no papers collected. Completion of the program is indicated by the progress on the scrapbooks which will be examined at the meetings in December, February and April.
- We follow Anne Arundel County Schools for weather closings. If weekend activities are cancelled, or a State of Emergency is in effect, there will be no meeting. Mass will still be held. Use your own discretion to keep your family safe.
